Handouts: Screenplay to Deal course action request, MS in Digital Media, Addictions Counseling Graduate Certificate, MA in Early Childhood Education, and courses and special topics.

1. Dr. Sivo began the meeting at 12:00 in Room 243 Millican Hall. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.
2. **From Screenplay to Deal course.** Steve Schlow gave an overview of this course. The committee had raised questions at the last meeting on whether this was a capstone course, if it could be taught in one semester, and if there were costs involved with the course. Professor Schlow indicated that they have been teaching the course as one semester already. Discussion followed regarding the costs of this course and also the overall program. Discussion was also held on copyright issues. Rhonda was asked to set up a meeting to discuss copyright issues with Natasha Hellerich, Ke Francis, and Patricia Bishop. This course received approval with one abstention.
3. **M.S. in Digital Media.** Ben Noel gave a summary of the changes to this program which included the title change to M.S. in Interactive Entertainment, deleting the track, and keeping the current HEGIS code in place. These changes received unanimous approval.
4. **Addition of a Graduate Certificate in Addictions Counseling.** Mike Robinson was available to discuss this certificate. He indicated that they would like to keep the courses that are in place right now but would like to talk more with Social Work about a collaboration. Mike Robinson, Steve Holmes, and John Ronnau agreed to have further conversation regarding this certificate. Dr. Robinson requested to table the certificate for further collaboration. This received unanimous approval from the committee.
5. **Changes to MA in Early Childhood Development.** Anne Culp gave an overview of the changes which included a name change to MA in Early Childhood Development and Education, changing the credit hours from 39 to 36, and deleting the initial certification track. They requested to keep the same HEGIS code as the original program. Dr. Culp mentioned that Dr. Lieberman, Chair of Communication Sciences and Disorders, has reviewed the changes and is in support of the revised program. Dr. Culp indicated that they have 25 students right now in the program and they have met with all of the students. Students may opt to keep this program or go into one of the other Education programs. These changes received unanimous approval.
6. **Course and special topics.** See attached list for course approvals.

Next meeting. The next meeting is scheduled for March 21, 12:00, 243 MH, which will be the last meeting date for any approvals or changes to be included in the next catalog.
