GRADUATE POLICY COMMITTEE MINUTES

Minutes of February 06, 2013 meeting

Welcome and call to order: Chair Moharam called the meeting to order and a quorum was established. Minutes were reviewed and approved.

Graduate Certificate Policies, GPA calculation. The committee reviewed the language that was revised at the last meeting. The reference to the Graduate Status GPA should be removed from the policy language. This revision was approved unanimously by the committee.

H/P/F grading – draft policies for implementation. Chair Moharam indicated that the H/P/F Grading Task Force was not able to meet in January so the resolution was sent via email for approval. The resolution was then reviewed. Brian Boyd indicated that there were 3 careers that they work with in the student information system: the medical, the graduates, and the undergraduates. The schedule is then built from the careers. For the courses, there are courses or sections. Once it becomes a scheduled class, it is a section. Types of grading are A-F and S/U grades with some sections having both. These are used for both UG and Grad. The medical school grading is different: A=excel, B=good, C=conditional, F=unexceptional, P=pass, and T=temporary grade remedial (assigned until they do remediation). Temporal grade indicates that they have completed some of the grade work. In the medical school, there is no GPA calculated on the transcript. In the medical school, the F grading indicates deficiency in that model and needs to be repeated. U transcript paper now includes medical grading. A comment was made that the way the resolution was written now that it could be used for other graduate programs later. Dr. Pepler gave an overview of the schemes and the H/P/F grading in the medical career. Dr. Moharam indicated that this committee could propose a change to the Steering Committee which was meeting on February 7. Dr. Moharam asked for a straw vote from the committee on changing the grading for the medical career only. All members were in favor of limiting this grading to the medical career only.
