Welcome and call to order.

Dr. Jackie Zhao, acting chair, called the meeting to order at 2:34p.m. and welcomed the committee and guests. A quorum was established. The minutes (curriculum, course) from the October 24, 2018 meeting were reviewed and approved.

General Business.

Dr. Devon Jensen explained that Committee members have a responsibility to review the agenda and report on any issues including course overlap or duplication that may impact their College. If any duplications are found, the course or program proposers need to be contacted and a conversation to review and approve the item must be documented. A College staff member could be assigned to review the agenda for these issues.

Dr. Jensen reminded Curriculog users of the importance of importing course and program information into proposals. He reminded the Committee that there are many fields in Curriculog, such as the course description, that will flow to the graduate catalog so these fields need to be correctly formatted and filled in completely.

Revision of Business Administration PhD tracks including: Accounting Track, Finance Track, and Marketing Track.

Dr. Theresa Libby explained that the revisions are to reduce credit hour requirements assisting in streamlining the process for training doctoral students. Students will complete coursework and begin dissertation work sooner. The track revisions received unanimous approval.

Revision of eLearning Design, Development, and Delivery Graduate Certificate.

Dr. Glenda Gunter explained that the revision is to change the name of the eLearning Professional Development Certificate to eLearning Design, Development, & Delivery Certificate. The department felt that the current name is misleading because the certificate incorporates more than professional development. The new name aligns with the curriculum of the program.
