**Addition of CCIE Master of Public Policy MPP.**

Drs. Naim Kapucu and Abdul-Akeem Sadiq explained that the program addition uses existing courses and includes one new capstone course. The faculty hired for the program are among the top in their field. The program will support the forthcoming PhD. The degree addition received unanimous approval.

**Addition of CCIE Secondary Education MED, World Languages Education Track.**

Dr. Janet Andreason explained the track addition will meet the needs of teachers of languages other than English and Dual Language teachers. The track addition received unanimous approval.

**Revision of CHPS Anatomical Sciences Graduate Certificate.**

Dr. Patrick Pabian explained the revision is to reduce required hours to 4 credit hours which will reduce the total credit hours to 20. An Elective course requirement was added and the credit hours for two courses (PHT 6510 and PHT 6119L) were increased. The certificate revision received unanimous approval.

**Revision of COS Anthropology MA.**

Dr. Beatriz Reyes-Foster explained the curriculum revisions are as follows: removing ANG 6002 as a required course, adding new required course ANG 5094, and adding two courses to elective options. The program revision received unanimous approval.
