Dr. Elsie Olan, chair, called the meeting to order at 2:35p.m. and welcomed the committee and guests. A quorum was established. The minutes (program, course) from the February 20, 2019 meeting were reviewed and approved.

Addition of CCIE Academic Advising Graduate Certificate.

Dr. Thomas Cox explained the certificate prepares professionals who are entering the field of academic advising to expand their knowledge of topics relevant to academic advising and provides a benefit to practicing academic advisors, administrators and faculty interested in becoming more knowledgeable in these areas. The certificate requires 16 credit hours of existing courses taught by existing faculty. The certificate addition received unanimous approval.

Addition of CCIE Housing and Residence Life Graduate Certificate.

Dr. Thomas Cox explained the certificate is designed to prepare individuals to become leaders and professionals in the residence life profession. The certificate requires 16 credit hours of existing courses taught by existing faculty. The certificate addition received unanimous approval.

Addition of CCIE Student Athlete Support Services Graduate Certificate.*Pending Library Director Signature

Dr. Thomas Cox explained the certificate is designed to assist entry level and current professionals to better perform associated duties in the various athletic academic content areas. The program also provides a benefit to practicing athletic advisors, administrators, and faculty interested in becoming more knowledgeable in these areas. The certificate requires 16 credit hours of existing courses taught by existing faculty. The certificate addition received unanimous approval.

Addition of CCIE Local Director of Career and Technical Education Graduate Certificate.

Dr. Lisa Martino explained the certificate is designed for Career and Technical Education teachers who wish to advance their career as a program director, coordinator, or other administrator type position. It is also for students interested in advancing their knowledge in

CTE professional education coursework. This certificate may, in part, prepare candidates to meet a portion of the State of Florida Department of Education Certification in Local Director of Career and Technical Education coursework requirements. The certificate is offered online requiring 15 credit hours of existing courses taught by existing faculty. The certificate addition received unanimous approval.

Revision of CCIE Career and Technical Education MA.

Dr. Lisa Martino explained the revision is to align the program with programs at other Universities. Revisions include changes to core and elective credit hours and adding a new course ECW 6260 to the Career Education Core. The program revision received unanimous approval.

Addition of CBA/CECS FinTech MS.

Dr. Sevil Sonmez explained this is a 30-credit cohort program offered jointly by the Department of Finance (College of Business) and Department of Computer Science (College of Engineering and Computer Science). The curriculum includes 5 courses in Finance and 5 courses in Computer Science. The program addition received unanimous approval.

Addition of CECS Healthcare Systems Engineering Graduate Certificate.

Dr. Vernet Lasrado explained the certificate is designed to prepare students to advance their careers in Healthcare Organization utilizing their Healthcare system engineering expertise. The certificate will be fully online and includes 15 hours of existing courses. The certificate addition received unanimous approval.

Addition of CGS Sustainable Coastal Systems PhD.* Pending OIE approval

Dr. Joe Donoghue explained the program will focus on advanced education in the human and natural processes and components that comprise, affect, and modify coastal systems. The program includes 5 new courses. The program addition received unanimous approval.

Revision of COS Sociology PhD.

Dr. Jay Corzine explained the revision will provide more flexibility for doctoral students in completing the requirements for the degree. Revisions include reducing the required credit hours from 21 to 15, and increasing the unrestricted electives credit hours from 12 to 18 hours. The program revision received unanimous approval.
