- 1. Dr. Sivo began the meeting at 12:00 in Room 243 Millican Hall. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.
- Course revisions to the Initial Teacher Prep graduate certificate. The committee reviewed the revisions but had several questions regarding the changes. This item was tabled and a representative from the department will be invited to the next meeting to give a brief summary of the changes.
- 3. Course revisions to the School Counseling track. Mike Robinson summarized the changes. State rule has had several changes in requirements in order to meet professional prep requirements for Florida certification. The department requested to delete course EDF 6608 and add course TSL 5373 in addition to several other course changes. These changes were approved by the committee.
- 4. Course and special topics. See attachment for the results of these courses.
- 5. Materials and supplies fee requests. Dr. Pherigo requested that a change from \$10 to \$20 be made in the fees for all of the courses that required music part sheets due to the reevaluation of the fee costs after the courses were approved last fall. This course correlates human nutrition with exercise physiology. Nutritional concepts are related to human performance and fitness

Course promotes in-depth understanding of the role of macronutrients in human nutrition and health enabling graduates to integrate knowledge into other aspects of their work.
