Handouts: Minutes from March 7, Revisions to the MA/MED in Exceptional Education, Revisions to the Finance track, Ph.D. in Business Administration, and courses and special topics.

- 1. Dr. Cole facilitated as chair as Dr. Sivo was not available to chair this meeting. The meeting began at 12:10 in Room 243 Millican Hall. Since there was not a quorum for this meeting, a motion was made and approved to ask additional members to vote on the agenda topics via email. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.
- 2. Revisions to the MS in Industrial Engineering. The department asked to withdraw this agenda item. This will be forthcoming at a later meeting.
- Revisions to the MA/MED in Exceptional Education. Lee Cross and Anne Culp attended from the department. Dr. Cross stated that their department comes under the purview of the Florida Department of Education and numerous mandated and legislated changes in state statutes in Florida regarding the initial teacher preparation programs have necessitated course changes to the MA and MED programs. Changes were made to the core in the M.A. program adding 2 TESOL courses which replaced two electives in the MA program. No changes to the M.ED. Recommended deletion of EDF 6432. The fifteen hours of co-requisites were directly from the previously revised and approved ITP program. All course revisions were approved. These revisions received unanimous approval.
- 4. Revisions to the Finance track in Ph.D. in Education. The program requested changes to the core courses, which increased the hours by six credits. Changes were also made to the electives. No changes in total number of hours. These revisions received unanimous approval.
- Course and special topics. Pediatrics II for APNs was approved. The two Engineering Technology courses remained tabled.

Next meeting. The next meeting is scheduled for April 4, 12:00, 243 MH, which will be the last meeting date until fall.
