Handouts: Minutes from March 21, Revisions to the MS in Industrial Engineering, Title change to the MA in Vocation Education, and courses and special topics.

1. Dr. Sivo began the meeting at 12:10 in Room 243 Millican Hall. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.
2. **Revisions to the MS in Industrial Engineering.** Dr. Reilly gave a summary of the changes to the program. The department requested suppression of the SEM track and curriculum specification changes for the program. Discussion was then held on whether the track should be inactivated completely or be removed from the graduate application and graduate catalog for a period of time. Dr. Reilly requested that the track be removed from the graduate application and also that a note be placed in the graduate catalog indicating that the track was not accepting applications at this time. By the end of fall, the department will review this track again in the fall and bring forth an update to the Graduate Council. These requests received unanimous approval from the committee.
3. **Title change to the MA in Vocational Education.** Jo Ann Whiteman gave the rationale for the change to the title of this program. Vocational education has vastly changed in the last decade. Vocational Education teaches people the skills to enter careers and these careers are becoming more and more technical. The new name requested for the program was Master of Arts in Career & Technical Education. No additional course changes were requested. This change received unanimous approval from the committee.
4. **Course and special topics.** PAF 7XXX Seminar on Social Capital and Public Affairs was approved pending approval from the Department of Political Science. Prior to this committee meeting, the Department of Sociology requested that the CCJ 6XXX Domestic Violence Research in Criminal Justice course be tabled due to possible course duplication. The committee voted to approve this course pending approval from the Department of Sociology. The committee requested that the Department of Criminal Justice contact the Department of Sociology to discuss any course duplications or conflicts. The results of the meeting should be forwarded in writing to the Graduate Council. AST 5XXX Advanced Astronomical Data Analysis new course and split class. The committee approved this course pending additional rationale that should include the differences between the 4 and 5000 level split. The committee indicated that there was not enough rationale provided for the differences between the two courses. See attachment to view the results of additional courses.
