Welcome and call to order. The meeting was called to order at 12:30 p.m. by Ram Mohapatra, chair, who welcomed guests and established a quorum. The minutes of the last meeting were approved with no changes.

Review of Graduate Equipment Fee Requests. Dr. Bishop shared a report about the use of materials and supplies fees that had been conducted by university auditors in academic units. The audit included percentages of collections spent, cash balances as of 6/30/09, and information on how the fees were being used. The committee then began review of the graduate equipment fee requests for 2010-11. Approval was recommended for requests from the MA in Communications program and for removal of the fee for the Engineering Technology program. The list of requested fees will go next to the Provost for review and approval after which it will be forwarded to the Board of Trustees.

Review of Material and Supplies Fee requests. Requests from the following courses were recommended for "non-approval" since it was felt that these costs should be borne by the students directly and not collected as a fee in the course: FIL 5419, FIL 6146, FIL 6596, FIL 6619, FIL 6649, MAE 5318. Requests from ZOO 5486 and CLP 6XXX (Career and Lifestyle Assessment) were recommended for approval. A list of all recommendations from the committee will next be sent to the Provost for review and approval. Please refer to the attachment for a complete list of fee requests approved.

Addition of an American Humanics option to the Master of Nonprofit Management, COHPA. The department requested to add an American Humanics option to both the program and the graduate certificate that would require students to take an additional Humanics workshop course. This would enable interested students to seek national certification in American Humanics. It was noted that it was not necessary to formally list this opportunity as an "option" but that a paragraph could be added to the catalog description explaining the opportunity for certification. The request was approved.

Course revision to the Emergency Management and Homeland Security certificate, COHPA. The department requests to move the PUR 6403 Crisis Public Relations currently in Group 2 to Group 1. The request was approved.

Course revisions to the Medical-Speech Language Pathology certificate, COHPA. The department requests to change the curriculum from specific required and elective courses to a group of 5 courses in which the student would choose 4 courses. The request was approved.

Deletion of the Multicultural/Multilingual Speech-Language certificate, COHPA. The department requested to delete this certificate due to the fact that one of the courses is no longer being taught and no students have enrolled in the program in the last two years. There will be no effect on the current faculty teaching assignments. The request was approved.

Course deletion to the Corrections Leadership Certificate, COHPA. The department requested to delete one of the courses from the elective course listing. The request was approved although it was noted that this type of change does not require Graduate Council approval.

Course revision to the Criminal Justice Master's Professional track, COHPA. The department requested add an "either/ or" option in two courses to the current list of required courses. The request was approved.

Courses and special topics. A number of courses and special topics were also reviewed and approved. For a complete list of courses approved, review the attachment listed at the top of this page.
