Welcome and call to order. The meeting was called to order at 12:00 p.m. by Joyce Nutta, chair. A quorum was established. The minutes of the 2/18 agenda were approved.

Initial Leader PK-12 Certification track inactivation, Ed Leadership EdD, COE. Dr. Bishop shared that the new Executive EdD track in Ed Leadership will replace this track and will begin admitting students for the fall semester 2010. The last students admitted in this track was a cohort group which will continue in the planned sequence until graduation. This track inactivation was approved.

Previous Leader PK-12 Certification track inactivation, Ed Leadership, EdD, COE. Dr. Bishop shared that the new Executive EdD track in Ed Leadership will replace this track and will begin admitting students for the fall semester 2010. The last students admitted in this track was a cohort group which will continue in the planned sequence until graduation. This track inactivation was approved.

Addition of a Social Science Education graduate certificate, COE. Scott Waring was present to give a summary of this new graduate certificate. He indicated that this certificate was for teachers who instruct students in social science content in grad levels K-12. The four courses are existing courses and may be incorporated into the MED program or taken as an add-on to an UG or graduate degree. The committee suggested adding language to the catalog copy that stated that students who completed the graduate certificate may transfer these credits into the M.Ed. in Social Science Education if they meet the acceptance criteria and were admitted. This certificate was approved with the change as indicated.

Revisions to the TESOL M.A. program, CAH. The department asked to withdraw this proposal to make additional revisions to it.

Addition of an e-Health Services Administration track, Health Sciences MS, COHPA. The committee tabled this track due to additional information needed on the budget and on faculty hiring and training.

Courses and special topics – The proposed changes to MAT 5711 were tabled awaiting clarification on the prerequisite. The committee approved the EDE 6938 capstone course with one change. They suggested that the prerequisite be changed to the following: to be taken with final internship.
