Welcome and call to order: Dr. Paul Dombrowski called the meeting to order and a quorum was established.

The minutes of the October 8th meeting were reviewed and approved.

The graduate faculty in the following departments were reviewed for reappointment and the graduate faculty recommendations were forwarded to Dr. Bishop.

Twenty-seven graduate faculty members were recommended for Full Graduate Faculty status and ten were recommended for Associate Graduate Faculty status. Some CVs lacked sufficient information in order for the committee to recommend the nominated status which will be solicited.

Psychology (Clinical Psychology, I/O Psychology, Applied Experimental & Human Factors)

Twenty graduate faculty members were recommended for Full Graduate Faculty status and eight were recommended for Associate Graduate Faculty status. Some full recommendations were not approved by the committee due to insufficient information in the nominee's CV which will be solicited.

Sociology

After receiving a table from the department that clarified the graduate teaching experience and committee work of the nominated faculty members from the Sociology department, the committee reviewed the nominations again. Seven graduate faculty members were recommended for Full Graduate Faculty status and five were recommended for Associate Graduate Faculty status.
