Welcome and call to order

General Business

The committee took nominations from the members for the Vice Chair role. Dr. Zemack-Rugar volunteered and was elected unanimously as the Vice Chair for the 2019-2020 academic year.

Overview of purpose and role of committee

Dr. Schoenfeld presented a PowerPoint on the committee's function and explained the related policies. The committee's charge to review the graduate faculty in the programs that will be examined as part of the 7-year cycle was explained. This year, the committee will review programs in the College of Health Professions and Sciences, the College of Community Innovation and Education, and the College of Graduate Studies. In the spring, any programs in which the external reviewers suggest be discontinued will be reviewed. The committee will also review the different graduate student awards for teaching, thesis, and dissertation, as well as, the review of the University Excellence in Graduate Teaching and the University Excellence in Graduate Mentoring awards.

Emily Stettner gave an overview of the Graduate Council website and Teams. It was explained the Graduate Council website is where information regarding the Graduate Council and the different subcommittees will be available. Meeting agendas, minutes, schedules, etc. for the Program Review Committee will be available on this site. For Teams, a demonstration was given on the location of materials for faculty review including worksheets, policy, and vitas.

Primary reviewers were discussed and assigned for faculty nominations for future meetings. The faculty in the College of Graduate Studies and the College of Community Innovation and Education will be reviewed during the next meeting on September 20th.
