Welcome and call to order.

Dr. Valeriya Shapoval, chair, called the meeting to order at 2:32p.m. and welcomed the committee and administrators. A quorum was established. The Minutes from the February 16, 2022 meeting were reviewed and approved.

Addition of RCHM Hospitality and Tourism Management MS, Intensive Track.

Dr. Alan Fyall explained the new track is an accelerated version of the Hospitality and Tourism Management MS designed to be completed in one year. The track will not include any new courses. The track addition received unanimous approval.

Suspension of CCIE Curriculum and Instruction MEd, Tracks: Curriculum Leadership Track; Educational Technology Track; Global, International and Comparative Education Track; Intervention Specialist Track; Supporting High Needs Populations Track.

Dr. Richard Hartshorne explained the suspensions are due to low enrollment over the past few years. Current students will be on a teach-out plan with the intention to terminate the tracks in the future. The suspensions received unanimous approval.

Suspension of CCIE Education PhD, Communication Sciences and Disorders Track.

Ranetta Guinn explained the track closed admissions in summer 2017. Current students will be on a teach-out plan with the intention to terminate the track in the future. The suspension received unanimous approval.

Suspension of CCIE Exercise Physiology, Education PhD.

Ranetta Guinn explained the faculty have moved to the College of Health Professions and Sciences with the recent college split. The intent is to replace this program with the Kinesiology PhD that is in development. The suspension received unanimous approval.

Termination of CCIE Education EdD.

Dr. Richard Hartshorne explained this degree is not active and does not have any students. The termination received unanimous approval.

Termination of CCIE Teacher Leadership MEd and all Tracks: Art Education Track; Curriculum Leadership Track; Educational Technology Track; English Language Arts Education Track; Global, International, and Comparative Education Track; Gifted Education Track; Intervention Specialist Track; Mathematics Education Track; Science Education Track; Social Science Education Track; Urban Education Track.

Dr. Richard Hartshorne explained this degree and all tracks are not active and do not have any students. The terminations received unanimous approval.

Revision of COS Big Data Analytics PhD.

Dr. Edgard Maboudou explained the revision is to update the list of elective courses. The program revision received unanimous approval.

Addition of CBA Business Analytics MS.

Dr. Lealand Morin explained the new degree is the final stage of a series of business analytics programs developed by the College of Business. It will focus on the application of mathematics and statistics to solve business problems. The program is a one-year, face-to-face program delivered over eleven months in a cohort format. The program addition received unanimous approval.

Revision of CBA Business Administration PhD, Tracks: Accounting Track; Finance Track; Management Track; Marketing Track.

Dr. Sevil Sonmez and Kelley Dietrich explained the revisions are to remove the foundation courses prerequisite requirement and increase elective requirements. For the Marketing Track, the revision will also clarify language for the research methods/tool options. The revisions to the tracks received unanimous approval.
