**Welcome and call to order.**

Dr. Patrick Pabian, vice chair, called the meeting to order at 2:30p.m. and welcomed the committee and administrators. A quorum was established. The Minutes from the March 2, 2022 meeting were reviewed and approved. The Minutes from this meeting will be emailed to the committee for approval.

**Revision of CGS Geographic Information Systems Graduate Certificate.**

Dr. John Walker explained the revision is to clarify language in the elective section and to add a course option to the Group C electives. The program revision received unanimous approval.

**Revision of CON Nursing Practice DNP, Executive Track.**

Dr. Veronica Decker explained the revision is to clarify language in the elective section. The track revision received unanimous approval.

**Revision of COM Biomedical Sciences PhD.**

Dr. Saleh Naser explained the revision is to required courses, elective courses, and dissertation hours. The program revision received unanimous approval.

**Program Admissions Hiatus of CCIE Supporting High Needs Populations Graduate Certificate.**

Dr. Richard Hartshorne explained the certificate has undergone a loss in coordination and enrollment numbers have decreased. Thus, the School of Teacher Education and associated programs are re-examining the program for future continuation. The program admissions hiatus received unanimous approval.

**Revision of CAH Professional Writing Graduate Certificate.**

Dr. Sherry Robertson explained the revisions are to the program's mission and description. The portfolio requirement is being removed. The Application Deadline Notes are being updated. The program revisions received unanimous approval.

### **Revision of CAH English, Rhetoric and Composition MA.**

Dr. Sherry Robertson explained the revisions are to the program's mission and description. The annotated bibliography requirement is being removed. The Application Materials are being updated and a fully online option is being added. The program revisions received unanimous approval.

### **Differentiated Admission Cycle of CHPS Athletic Training MAT, UCF BS to UCF MAT Track.**

Dr. Kristen Schellhase explained the track is causing confusion for applicants. The Track will stop admissions temporarily until a better solution is determined. The program differentiated admission cycle received unanimous approval.

### **Revision of CHPS Communication Sciences and Disorders MA, Accelerated BA/BS to MA Track.**

Dr. Jacqueline Towson explained the revisions are to: the track description, course credit hours, moving courses to different sections of the curriculum, track prerequisites, application requirements, application deadlines, and the sample plan of study schedule. The track revisions received unanimous approval.

### **Revision of CHPS Communication Sciences and Disorders MA, Out of Field Track.**

Dr. Jacqueline Towson explained the Track was implemented in 2013 as the Foundations Track but was never published in the catalog. The revision includes a name change and updating the catalog entry for publication. The track revisions received unanimous approval.

### **Revision of CHPS Communication Sciences and Disorders MA.**

Dr. Maxine McGregor explained the revision is to update the Track's name from "traditional" to "campus-based" in the catalog copy due to their recently approved name changes. The program revision received unanimous approval.

### **Revision of COS Chemistry PhD.**

Dr. Treen Huo explained the revision is to add course elective options, change the seminar credit wording and revise the candidacy exam policy. The word "Chemical" was revised to "Chemistry" in the program description section. Discussions took place about the overlap with

CCIE's chemistry education offerings, and it was agreed that the wording would not be revised. The program revision received # approve votes and 1 dissent vote.

Dr. Elena Sequera explained the revision is to update the elective course offerings and remove the GRE from the application requirements. The program revision received # approve votes and 1 dissent vote.

**Revision of COS Security Studies PhD.**

Dr. Timothy Hawthorne explained the extensive revisions to all parts of the program are a result of strategic planning to elevate the program to compete with other top 50 Sociology programs in the US. The program revisions received unanimous approval.

Tonya Walker explained the track addition will allow students to pursue statistical methodology research that involves extensive theory development. The track addition received unanimous approval.
