**Welcome and call to order.** Dr. Valeriya Shapoval, chair, called the meeting to order at 2:30p.m. and welcomed the committee, administrators, and guests. A quorum was established. The minutes from the February 1, 2022 meeting were reviewed and approved.

#### Announcements.

Dr. John Weishampel announced the upcoming deadlines for program pre-proposals to be submitted to the Council of Academic Vice Presidents-Academic Coordination Group.

#### Graduate Certificate Sunsetting Report.

The committee reviewed the Graduate Certificate Sunsetting Report. The committee decided that the inactive program should be given notice prior to the official sunsetting memo request. The committee tabled the process until the program is notified. The committee requested that certificates that have low enrollment be notified of the sunsetting process and the possibility of their certificate being included in this process in the future.

## Addition of CHPS Kinesiology MS, Clinical Exercise Physiology Track.

Dr. David Fukuda and Dr. Sarah Fretti explained the new track will incorporate new courses and fill a gap in current offerings. The track will seek accreditation by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) which will be a future requirement for students taking the ACSM-CEP exam. The track addition received unanimous approval.

#### **Revision of CHPS Kinesiology PhD.**

Dr. David Fukuda and Dr. Sarah Fretti explained the revision is to change core courses and to clean up the redundancy of research methods courses. A leadership course will be added to core courses. The program revision received unanimous approval.

#### **Revision of CHPS Kinesiology MS.**

Dr. David Fukuda and Dr. Sarah Fretti explained the revision is to provide options for students to take new courses. The revision will reduce elective credits and reduce the total hours from 36 to 30 to align this program with other programs in the state. The anatomical sciences specialization is being removed due to limited interest and to streamline program offerings. The program revision received unanimous approval.

# Revision of COS Statistics and Data Science MS; Statistics and Data Science MS, Data Science Track.

Dr. Jongik Chung explained the revisions are to remove the comprehensive exam and replace it with a research project to align with current trends in the field. The revision to the program and track received unanimous approval.

# **Revision of COS Sociology, Applied MA.**

# Suspension of Sociology, Applied MA, Domestic Violence Track; Sociology, Applied MA, Medical Sociology Track.

Dr. Tim Hawthorne explained the revision includes removing the tracks. The tracks will be suspended with the intention to terminate them once all students have graduated. Additional revisions to the MA include editing language to clarify specialization options, changes to required and elective courses, and adding a final project. The program revision and track suspensions received unanimous approval.

## **Revision of COS Sociology PhD.**

Dr. Tim Hawthorne explained the revision is add a methods course option to better align with the strengths of the program. The program revision received unanimous approval.

## **Revision of COS Clinical Psychology PhD.**

Dr. Jeffrey Bedwell explained the revision will change the total credit hours from 86 to 90 due to changes in credit hours required for clinical courses. The change is for accreditation purposes. The program revision received unanimous approval.

## **Revision of COS Communication MA.**

Kim Tuorto explained the revision is to add a minimum grade requirement to the research methods area. The program revision received unanimous approval.

# **Revision of COS Strategic Communication PhD.**

Dr. Jennifer Sandoval explained the revision is to remove the health communication concentration and associated course changes due to changes in program faculty. Elective course options were added. The program revision received unanimous approval.

## **Revision of COS Chemistry PhD.**

Dr. Erin Saitta explained the revision is to add a chemistry education research concentration and change elective course options which will offer flexibility to students. Elective course options were changed. The program revision received unanimous approval.

# Revision of COS Integrative and Conservation Biology PhD.

# Suspension of Integrative and Conservation Biology PhD, Integrative Biology Track; Integrative and Conservation Biology PhD, Conservation Biology Track.

Dr. Kate Mansfield explained the revision includes removing the tracks. The tracks will be suspended with the intention to terminate them once all students have graduated. Additional revisions to the PhD include changes to electives to remove the restriction on pre-candidacy research. The program revision and track suspensions received unanimous approval.
