Reactivation of CAH Emerging Media MFA, Studio Art and Design Track; Animation and Visual Effects Track.

Jason Burrell and Anastasia Salter explained the revision is to reactivate the tracks after an administrative error to suspend them. The track reactivations received unanimous approval.

Revision of CAH Texts and Technology PhD.

Anastasia Salter explained the revision is to add a procedural literacy course to the degree requirements. The program revision received unanimous approval.

Revision of CECS Civil Engineering MSCE.

Dr. Naveen Eluru explained the revisions are to program prerequisites, articulation courses and to clean-up the curriculum. The program revision received unanimous approval.

Suspension of CREOL Optics and Photonics MS, Optics Track; Photonics Track.

Dr. Patrick LiKamWa explained the track suspensions are an effort to streamline the curriculum and combine the track curriculum into the Optics and Photonics MS program. The suspension of the tracks received unanimous approval.

Revision of CBA Business Administration PhD, Marketing Track.

Dr. Xin He explained the revisions are to modernize the curriculum and to make it more competitive with peer institutions. The revision will add flexibility to course offerings. The revision of the track received unanimous approval.

Addition of COS Clinical Psychology MS, Master Along the Way Track.

Dr. Daniel Paulson explained the addition is to formalize the Master Along the Way Track of the Clinical Psychology PhD. The track addition received unanimous approval.

Revision of COS Interactive Entertainment MS.

Benjamin Noel explained the revision is to add flexible language to the specialization area. The program revision received unanimous approval.

Revision of COS Communication MA.

Dr. Ann Miller explained the revision is degree requirements, aligning thesis hour requirements with college and university practices. The revision also lowers the total program credit hours from 33 to 30 hours. The program revision received unanimous approval.

Revision of CCIE Community Engagement Graduate Certificate.

Dr. David Mitchell explained the revision is to change the name of the certificate from Social Justice in Public Service and to revise the curriculum to broaden the focus. The program revision received unanimous approval.

Revision of CCIE Public Management and Leadership Graduate Certificate.

Dr. David Mitchell explained the revision is change the name of the certificate from Public Administration and to revise the curriculum to focus more on management and leadership. The program revision received unanimous approval.

Revision of CCIE Public Affairs PhD, Public Administration MPA Dual Degree Track.

Edlira Dursun explained the revision is to degree requirements to align the track with the standalone program. The track revision received unanimous approval.

Addition of CCIE Local Government Management Graduate Certificate.

Dr. David Mitchell explained the certificate is designed to meet a growing need in our local governments to understand their varied and complex challenges and the ability to apply effective and innovative management practices. The certificate aligns with the strength of the faculty and will leverage the City of Orlando fellowship opportunities. The program addition received unanimous approval.

Program Differentiated Admission Cycle of CCIE Student Athlete Support Services Graduate Certificate.

Dr. Thomas Cox explained the program differentiated admission cycle will allow the opportunity to evaluate appropriate faculty needs and improve marketing to increase enrollment while admission is halted.
