

## Restricted Graduate Status

### Proposed Amendment:

Even though minimum university application requirements are met, a graduate program may attach restrictions to the admission of an applicant, such as higher GPA requirements, completing a standardized test, completing certain prerequisite courses, maintaining a certain GPA in the first few hours of a graduate program, etc. Students may be denied admission to regular graduate status if the restrictions are not met.

Students who ~~have a graduate GPA of less than 3.0 while in graduate status or that have been placed on probation or~~ dismissed from a degree program due to a Program GPA that is less than 3.0 at UCF and are admitted into a new program will may be considered for readmission admitted to the same program into the new program in with restricted graduate status. Upon satisfactory completion of a minimum of nine credits within the respective graduate program, students may be admitted to regular graduate status.

### Effective Term: Fall 2025

**Rationale:** Aligns with Program GPA policy, which is calculated for each degree program. Clarifies that students are required to achieve a Program GPA of 3.0 by the end of the semester in which they have completed a minimum of nine credits. Specifies expectations for students readmitted following dismissal for failure to meet minimum GPA requirement.
